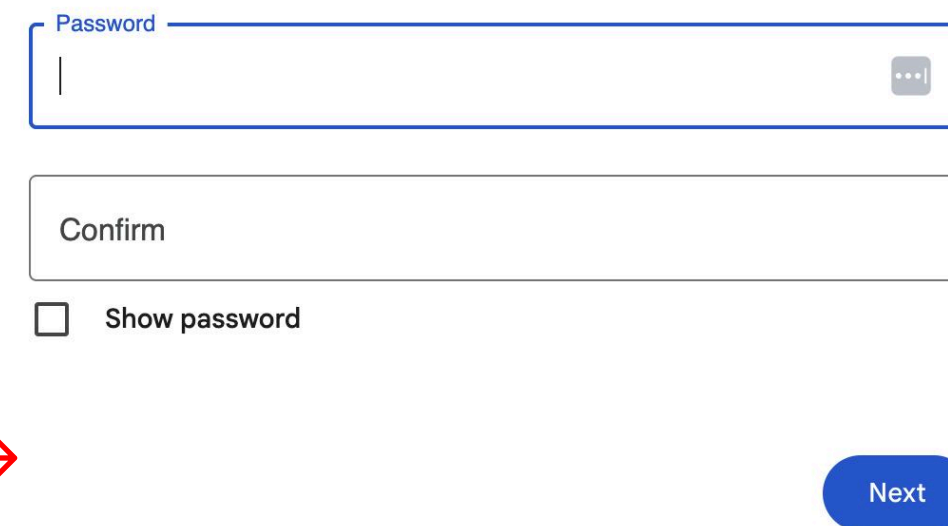

This recommendation also aligns with existing navigation patterns, improving consistency, user control, and ease of navigation.
